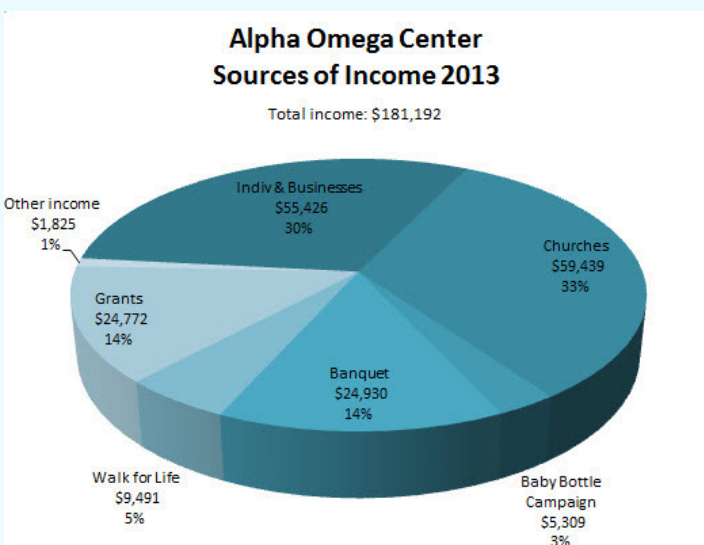

About 38 % of our clients were abortion-vulnerable or abortion-minded in 2013.

Alpha Omega Center's vision is to reduce the number of unwanted pregnancies and abortions in our community. Once a woman is pregnant, presenting the truth in a supportive environment is often what is needed to prevent an abortion. Women who have ultrasounds often decide to continue their pregnancies. We have seen a number of women change their minds about abortion after viewing their baby in an ultrasound picture.



## LifeMatters

Alpha Omega Center strives to educate young people about healthy relationships which includes saving sex for marriage. Our LifeMatters teachers give interactive presentations that engage students in discussion about topics such as teen pregnancy, STDs, and investing in their future marriage relationship. We also provide them with strategies to help them put their choices into action in the face of peer pressure.

In 2013 we worked in the three counties in our service area. We worked with all eight school districts in Lawrence County, with five school districts in Mercer County, and three school districts in Butler County. Our surveys show that after our presentations, approximately 90% of students showed movement towards the abstinence position.

## New Beginnings

In our New Beginnings program, Parenting Educators work with pregnant and parenting moms and their families using our Earn While You Learn curriculum. Our curriculum teaches new parents about topics such as prenatal development, crib safety, bonding with your child, etc. We develop long term relationships with our families, and encourage them as they embark on the journey of parenthood. In exchange for attending classes parents earn "mommy money" that they can spend in our store on items such as diapers, wipes, clothing, furniture, and
